NEWPORT, RI

- Saturday, April 18th
- The course was rated by Competitor Magazine as the Most Scenic in the Northeast.
- The course starts and finishes at famous First Beach, hits all the iconic Newport locations including the Bellevue Mansions, Fort Adams, Salve Regina University, Hanging Rock, Sachuest Beach and more.
- Spend Spring in Newport and come alive with the start of the running season. Dash through the Daffodils!



PROVIDENCE, RI

- Sunday, May 5th
- Top Bucket List Small City Marathon by Runner's World
- The course starts and finishes right in the heart of DownCity. Run along the river before heading out along Narragansett Bay, enjoy the picturesque bike path or famous Blackstone Boulevard.
- Get your BQ in PVD - a highly ranked Boston Qualifying race.



BRISTOL, RI

- Saturday, June 27th
- Part of the Oldest 4th of July Celebration in America
- The course starts and finishes in Independence Park, site of the 4th of July concerts. Enjoy beautiful architecture from the home of the early colonial ship builders then head out on a spit of land towards the Bristol Yacht Club, Coggeshall Farm and stunning Colt State Park.
- Rich in sailing history, a small town with great local shops and accessibility. Most Patriotic City.



JAMESTOWN, RI

- Saturday, September 19th
- Boundless water views
- The course starts and finishes in Fort Getty, an old military embattlement. Circumvent the entire island while enjoying sailboats bob in the harbor, majestic windmills, peaceful estuaries and gorgeous views of the Newport Bridge.
- Jamestown defines small town coastal New England charm.



NARRAGANSETT, RI

- Sunday, October 25th
- Happiest Seaside Town, as voted by Coastal Living
- The course starts and finishes at the famous Narragansett Town Beach. Wind past wide open views of Narragansett Bay, beautiful working farms, quiet tree lined backroads, river paths and ancient stone walls.
- Site of the original Ocean State Marathon - where RI running got its start.
